

Job Title: Student Ministry Worship Leader

Status: Part-Time, up to 10 Hours per week, non-exempt

Reports to: Student Ministry Pastor

#### Job Vision

The Student Ministry Worship Leader will help create, administrate, prepare, and implement worship elements for the First Christian Student Ministry. They will also be responsible for the preparation and execution of the regular midweek services, including all creative elements such as audio, video, lights, sound, etc. They will take the lead on teaching, training, and the development of volunteers both in the student worship team and the student production team. They will ensure that the Student Ministry worship environment is achieving excellence as it creates worship experiences specific to middle school and high school students.

#### **Principal Duties:**

- Plan and execute Student Ministry worship experiences.
- Organize, prepare, and lead Student Ministry Worship Team rehearsals
- Recruit, organize, and equip Student Ministry worship team
- Manage/aid in the design, engineering, implementation, and maintenance of production related systems in the Student Ministry area.

## Specific Responsibilities:

- Work with the Student Ministry Pastor to plan worship each week that fits the topic of the week
- Lead worship for student ministry
- Use Planning Center Services to manage the worship team
- Utilize tracks to supplement and enhance worship capabilities
- Recruit & train students for the worship team.
- Recruit adult worship volunteers to supplement needed roles.
- Find and provide resources for the worship students
- Setup all audio video and lighting for Midweek
  - This includes ProPresenter (setting up slides and sometimes creating slides for the message), setting up the stage, soundboard, and lights.
- Manage the student ministry production team and train them

### Requirements and Qualifications:

This position also requires a level of experience/education suitable for fulfilling the responsibilities outlined above.

- Experience with leading worship and proficiency on guitar/keys.
- Experience with AVL technology in a modern worship production environment
- Capability of using/learning DAW software (Abelton, Multitracks, etc.) to create worship tracks.
- The ability to work cooperatively and jointly with ministry leaders, organizations, and volunteers.
- Strong organizational and problem-solving skills.

- The ability to manage time effectively and meet deadlines.
- Communicate well in both writing and speech.
- Manage work effectively and prioritize the tasks at hand.
- Ability to troubleshoot as issues arise, and either fix or communicate what's needed in order to fix.
- You appreciate creativity.
- You understand technology.
- You exude professionalism.
- The ideal candidate must have a mature, personal relationship with Jesus Christ, a pastoral heart for the people, a passion for Christ's mission in the world, and a love for prayer and worship.
